If you use illegal drugs your DIP worker can:

- refer you for counselling, prescribing and health checks
- give advice on reducing harm to yourself and how to avoid relapse
- offer needle exchange within police custody
- offer a pathway for a Drug Rehabilitation Requirement (DRR)
- help with things such as housing and benefits.

Your worker can support you in the community before sentence and also if you are discharged or you get a fine.

If you are remanded or sentenced we can refer you to drugs workers in prison.
